








 Sit quietly and wait for the performance to start.






 The lights will go dark.










 An announcement will introduce the conductor and orchestra.

The dancers, conductor and orchestra will bow in turn.



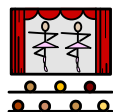
